EVENT REPORT

CR2: The 'Wuden Top' Rally

1 February

The second round of the Road Rally Championship was a KLMC event starting from The Three Horseshoes, Roydon, near Kings Lynn. A full entry included 12 EEMC members taking part in the event, which featured short and sharp sections ranging from 2.5 to 7 miles long. From the Roydon start, the route first headed south towards East Winch before branching off to the east again for the second section.

From the second control near East Walton, competitors were routed as far south as Swaffham and to the east across to Litcham. The route

included the well-known hump back bridge at Narford although a couple of crews missed this part of the route on a multiple herringbone handout.

Only two crews completed the route without any fails as the navigation tightened up towards the end of the rally, including a curious handout featuring a simple circle. This was in fact another herringbone - a circular one - but with no junctions! The section was just two miles long - straight down one piece of road between controls.

The exciting and enjoyable evening's sport was monitored by two Club-appointed observers as part of KLMC's programme of self-regulation and control and declared a great success by them, the competitors and event organisers Mike Baker and Tony Duckhouse.

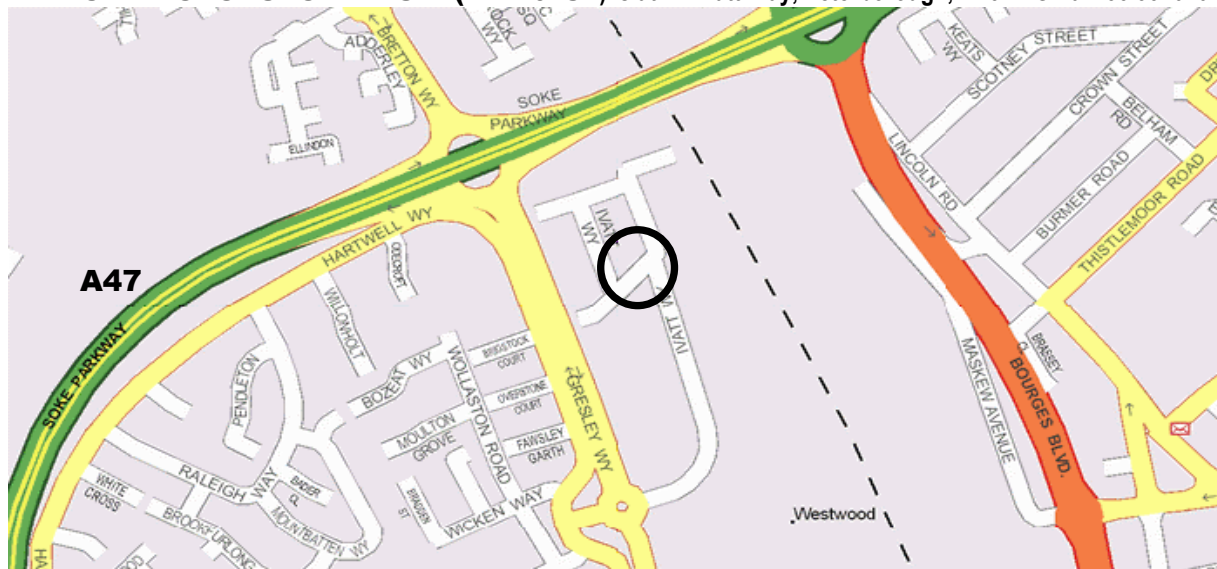
