I had been expecting to marshal when I had a phone call on the day asking if I could navigate for Simon as his normal navigator had had a mishap. I contemplated asking for the beginner instructions as I only tend to enter one rally a year. There were ten entries, three beginners and seven novices and, with plenty of marshals, it was a very good turnout.

We started as car 11, with the standard novice instructions, which were well presented even if I did have to scratch my head to work them out.

The first section saw us loop from Hillington through West Newton to TC1 near Anmer. I did get a bit concerned when we saw Gary White travelling in the opposite direction, fortunately we seemed to plot the right route and lost no time.

The second section was made up of grid lines to cross in order and didn't take too long to plot taking us to TC2 without too many problems except deciding which way to go round the triangles.

The route took me a while to plot as I seemed to be having difficulty telling yellow roads from white roads and I think this is where we lost most of our time. we also missed a short white and took a different one as I think some others did. Jean and Carol taking an alternative route although they were behind us at TC3.

Navigation from TC4 to TC5 was squares representing grid squares with an in arrow and an out arrow with one square having three arrows. We saw a couple of other competitors on this section not necessarily going in our direction so I double checked that we hadn't taken a wrong turn and fortunately we were correct. When we arrived at TC5 we were dazzled by the gaggle of

marshals' reflective jackets; as Simon said, "more jackets than the whole of the Norfolk Constabulary".

From TC5 to the end I tried plotting on the move which was fine till we came to a junction that I wasn't expecting. After doubling back to the correct route we picked up the PC on a large grass triangle and managed to find our way to the finish in a layby beside the A148.

I will look forward to Adrian's novice event on 18th April although I don't yet know if it will be as a competitor or a marshal.
