Gymkhana: 18 July

This should have been round 3 of the Gymkhana championship. Unfortunately the June event had to be cancelled due to a waterlogged field, despite the brave attempt to reschedule it for a week later.

This month's event was much drier, and was once again held at Saracens Head courtesy of Robert Oldershaw. Gary White, organising his first gymkhana had drawn up 6 tests for us all to attempt.

Test 1 started down the left hand side of 3 cones a 360 round the bottom one, before slaloming back down the right hand side & shooting back past the first cone to return the can that had been picked up at the start.

Test 2 was again down the left hand side, but after we crossed to the other side, we had to reverse round 2 cones, before swinging back into the finish.

Test 3 slalomed 3 cones & into a taped off box at the end, where we had to turn round & slalom back to the finish.

Test 4 was the same cone layout as test 3, but this time we had to stop between cones 2 & 3, before reversing into the box at the end. Turning round & reversing out, between the opposite side of cones 2 & 3, then back round the first cone & into the finish.

Test 5 looked like a piece of spaghetti looping from right to left round the 5 cones.

Test 6 sent us round 3 cones, before reversing round the next one & forward round the last four.

Congratulations to Dave who took the honours by one second from yours truly when the results were checked. Thanks to Gary White for organising an enjoyable evening's entertainment & also to his team of timekeepers. See you at the inter-club event.
