Inter-club gymkhana

13 Aug 2008 — EEMC vs KLDMC

This was the final gymkhana of the year and with less than two hours before it was due to start, it looked like it was going to be cancelled. Earlier in the day Greg Bates had given the all clear for the use of his field, but as the day

progressed there was some heavy rainfall that meant Greg's field was not going to be available. Some last minute phone calls proved successful and the event was transferred to Saracens Head thanks to Sara and Robert Oldershaw.

There were seven entries who braved the elements to attempt the tests drawn up by Dave Pollard. Test one must have been the shortest test ever. It was round one cone, into a taped box, a 180 in the box before going the opposite side of the first cone to finish. Mike Baker and I both got the fastest time but I was a second quicker than him on the first run. Gary White was another second down and Simon Leonard a second behind that.

Test 2 required us to slalom 7 cones, reverse half way back, swap direction and nip back round the first into the finish. Once again Mike and I had the quickest times, but Mike drew level by beating me by a second on his second run. Test three looped round five posts shaped like a dice. Gary White and Mike both posted fastest times here which put Mike two seconds in the lead.

Test four was back to the box, this time entering in reverse, a 180 and then out again. Mike and I were fastest again but I managed to halve his lead by making up one second on my second run.

Test 5 went round four of the seven cones in test 2 before reversing back round the last one and spinning round the second cone. Mike was fastest here beating my best time by three seconds, however my first run was three seconds better than Mike's so I was still trailing by one second.

In the end, it all came down to test 6. Once again we used the dice shaped test but with a different route. Mike's first run was 33 seconds; >>>>>> to page 3
